

Academic Intervention Services (AIS) are supplemental instruction and/or student support services intended to assist students in meeting the expectations of the Common Core Learning Standards.

The State Education Department regulations require that for the 2016-17 school year, districts use a two- step process to determine which students are in need of Academic Intervention Services (AIS.) First, all students receiving a score below a median scale score on either the ELA or Math assessment will be considered for AIS. Then, upon identification of a student for consideration of AIS, the district will use a district established protocol (using multiple measures) at each grade level for determining which students will receive AIS in the upcoming school year.

The table below indicates the mean scale score to be used in determining if a child will be considered for AIS.
