CALL TO ORDER Trustee D'Orazio called **REGULAR MEETING** to order at approximately 7:00 p.m.

Trustee Bernholz arrived approximately 7:03 p.m.

WELCOME TO BENNETT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL	Bennett Elementary School Principal Laurie Cassel welcomed everyone to Bennett School and introduced first grade teachers Kathy Carle and Joyce Hellenschmidt and first graders Madison Jones, Kylie Kleine, Zachary Chartrand, Atticus Johnson, Cassidy Lohrer, Cooper Estes, Bailey Kretschmer, and Ben Rauschendorfer who demonstrated the value of the fully implemented Trailblazers integrated math and science curriculum by engaging the Board members.
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DISTRICT NEWS Superintendent Jordan announced that:

- The Boys Varsity Basketball team is playing tonight and has not lost a game yet when he has been in attendance.
- JV Girls Basketball team did win their game.
- He had received a letter regarding a concern about the maintenance of the girls' locker room and a lack of storage, which really needs to be addressed.

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- He brought up to Administrators the idea for a suggestion box for fiscal ideas to improve the day-to-day efficiency of the school's operation in terms of finance or to perhaps appropriate our money in some different ways.
- Gayle Kavanagh, at the Middle School, had two events: the Publisher's Convention where students practiced persuasive speaking using marketing strategies to promote literature and the Battle of the Books Project where teams were created and they are now reading the 15 book requirement and planning strategies to win the Jeopardy-like competitions that will follow.
- There was an article in the Freeman about Highly Qualified teachers and the improvement reported by the SED for Onteora. He thanked the teachers who got the appropriate certification and the administrators, not only for helping them move in that direction, but also for hiring Highly Qualified people. 98% of the teachers in the District are now considered Highly Qualified.

Trustee Vanacore reported that Onteora's Boys Basketball Team was complimented by a Rondout Valley school board member for their sportsmanship, the way they acted, the way they played and even the referees said how well they represented our District at a recent game at Rondout. Our coaches said it is a collaborative effort with the teachers supporting the athletic department.

Trustee Bernholz reported that 17 students qualified for the State competition through DECA.

Bennett Principal Laurie Cassel announced that there is an Art Show on January 20 that will coincide with the Penny Social and every student will have at least three pieces in the Art Show.

Assistant Superintendent Deborah Fox reported that there will be a half day Staff Development on Friday, January 12, 2007, where secondary teachers and staff will attend a program on current adolescent drug trends and elementary teachers will be attending a program on the ABC's of data. Teaching assistants and monitors will participate in Managing and Engaging Students with Difficult Behaviors, which is a follow-up to a workshop they received last year. In addition to that our school nurses, music and P.E. will have programs going on and our middle and high school departments will be working on curriculum and looking at student data as well.

REPORT FROM 2005-2006 STUDENT BOARD REPRESENTATIVE Student Representative Frances Barlow reported that the chapter of Amnesty International is doing a lot to raise awareness and raise money for Darfur. They are selling bracelets and t-shirts and are also holding a two-part forum for grades 7-12. The first part, which may be held on February 7, is informational and they will have a guest speaker who is an expert on gender violence. The second part will be a public forum for kids to talk about it on February 13.

Superintendent Jordan mentioned that Amnesty International is thinking of sponsoring a ski program for underprivileged kids from the city to come here to ski and snowboard. He commended Amnesty for the idea.

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STUDENT COMMENT No student comments were made at this time.

PUBLIC COMMENT

- Corey Cavallaro, OTA President, accompanied by representatives of OTA, ONTEA and OAA, spoke about the Board's recent decision in hiring a new superintendent. He stated their commitment to the District in a spirit of cooperation and made suggestions on the following priorities: the bond issue, the budget, contract negotiations, the Shared Decision Making policy and utilization of the new superintendent's exceptional interpersonal skills to work within community groups to create and sustain positive relationships in the Onteora community that will encourage the support of our school district's endeavors.
- Tobe Carey spoke about energy issues related to the capital project.
- Audit Committee Report Trustee Bernholz reported that the next meeting is scheduled for January 16 at 8:30 a.m.
- Communications Committee Trustee O'Connor reported that the next meeting is scheduled for January 22 at 6:30 p.m.
- Facilities Committee Trustee Resnick reported that the Committee met the first week of January and will be meeting again on January 17 on two primary issues: infrastructure priorities of the District and Excel Aid.
- Policy Committee Trustee O'Connor reported that the first reading of the Title I Parent Involvement Policy is on this agenda to meet State requirements for Title I.

Trustee Vanacore reported that mandated policies need to take priority. She has been reviewing the section on the Board.

- Technology Committee Trustee Vanacore reported that their meeting was canceled and the next meeting will be on February 12 at 2:30 p.m.
- Coaching Athletic Director, Mike Kocher spoke about the State criteria for coaches and the difficulties experienced in hiring coaches. The possibility and obstacles of elementary teachers coaching were discussed.

Trustee D'Orazio called for a ten-minute break at approximately 8:23 p.m.

After discussion, a date of Saturday, March 3, 2007, with a snow date of Saturday, March 10, 2007 was agreed upon. Preliminary Budget Discussion – Assistant Superintendent Victoria McLaren and Superintendent Jack Jordan requested that the Board provide some general ideas of the direction they wish to go when constructing the 2007-2008 budget. Some of the factors that had an effect on the 2006-2007 budget after it was finalized were briefly reviewed.
