Dear Onteora Families,

As our closure continues, we are hoping that you are all staying healthy and enjoying this time with each other. With any luck, the weather will continue to be pleasant and everyone can get outside and enjoy some sunshine. We miss your children terribly, and are hopeful that we will be back in school in the near future. While our official return to school date is April 2nd, I do anticipate that we may soon hear from Governor Cuomo that this closure will actually be longer than he originally announced.

With that in mind, as you know, our staff has been working hard to prepare for continuing to support our students in this very different environment. Beginning next week, our teachers will be making contact with their students, providing work and direction, and creating a new sense of normal as much as possible. As we embark on this next phase, please remember that this is new for all of us. We have noticed that the capacity of the internet is being stressed and your students may experience service disruptions while interacting with their classes. This is something that we unfortunately cannot control, and with so much of the country working and learning from home, it is unavoidable. Please refer to the Instruction Update dated March 24, 2020

We are going to begin slowly and let our students get acclimated to this way of learning. You can expect to see welcome posts, interaction posts, videos, and even a couple of live interactions using Google Meets (Hangouts). Upper grades will continue to see assignments that will need to be submitted as well. Please note that beginning Monday, all K-8 students should log in to their google classrooms using their school email address. Many of you have received devices from the district and have been getting your students signed on. We have also heard from a number of families that were not part of our first distribution for one reason or another. We are aware that there are still families that need a device and are creating a plan for a second round of distribution early next week. More information will be shared tomorrow.
