Meeting the Mandate

- » District is partnering with Neal Smoller (Village Apothecary) to meet NYS mandated weekly screening test requirements
- Three District testing sites identified Phoenicia, Woodstock, Boiceville Campus
- » All staff were surveyed week of 9-13-21
- » Testing is commencing this week @ Phoenicia & Woodstock; next week @ Boiceville campus
- » Initial testing of 166 individuals
- » Expanding testing
 - All substitutes
 - Any students whose parent opts-in (target date 10-15-21)
