Budget Update

- Consumer Price Index (CPI) 1.81%
 - CPI of 2% would have resulted in \$82,000 additional in tax levy
- Tax Cap allows Districts to exempt BOCES Capital expenses as part of the tax cap
 - 20-21 year \$75,521


- Enrollment data consists of fall student counts from NYSED

- Annual live birth counts by the mother's home ZIP Code are obtained from the New York State, Department of Health. ZIP codes used for the district's birth counts represent all ZIP codes that are represented within the district boundaries, but portions of those codes may also be outside the district.
- Live births are offset six years to compare to kindergarten enrollments for comparative purposes.








ONTEORA CSD Enrollment Story

The stacked bars below show the percentage of students each year by race/ethnicity.





























Combined Wealth Ratio Breakdown
